THE CAROL PLAYERS

THE CAROL PLAYERS WON THE SUB-REGIONAL DRAMA FESTIVAL AT CORNER BROOK ON SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 21st. THIS WIN GIVES TO LABRADOR CITY AND WABUSH THE HONOUR OF REPRESENTING THE WESTERN NEWFOUNDLAND DIVISION AT THE REGIONAL FESTIVAL BEING HELD IN GANDER ON MARCH 17 TO 21st.

THE CAROL PLAYERS "SPOON RIVER" WAS DIRECTED BY A PROFESSIONAL DIRECTOR, MISS PATRICIA CARROLL BROWN. THE PLAYMAKERS OF CORNER BROOK PRESENTED THE PLAY "J.B." BY ARCHIBALD MCLEICH, DIRECTED BY JIM BOYLES.

THE ADJUDICATOR OF THE TWO DAY FESTIVAL WAS MRS. EVELYN GARBARY, A LADY OF GREAT CHARM AND GRACE, AN AGELESS WONDER TO THOSE WHO PARTICIPATED IN THE FESTIVAL.

THE CAROL PLAYERS, SHE SAID, SHOWED GOOD PROFESSIONAL TECHNIQUE AND HAD EXCELLENT SPEECH AND DICTATION WHICH SUPPORTED THEM THROUGH A DIFFICULT FIRST ACT. THERE WAS GREATER WARMTH IN THE SECOND ACT, MRS. GARBARY AGREED, WHICH WAS COMMUNICATED TO AN AUDIENCE OF WELL-WISHING CORNER BROOKERS (AND A FEW HOME-SICK LABRADORIANS WHO HAD BEEN ON THE ISLAND AND HAD GONE TO CORNER BROOK WITH THE CAROL PLAYERS FOR THE FESTIVAL)

MRS. GARBARY STATED THAT SINCE THE PLAY "SPOON RIVER" GAVE NO GUIDE LINES TO THE DIRECTOR AS TO HOW THE PLAY MIGHT BE STAGED OR COSTUMED, THE SET AND COSTUMES CAME STRAIGHT OUT OF TATY BROWN'S IMAGINATION, AND WERE PERFECT. THE ADJUDICATOR SAID THAT MISS BROWN USED EVERY TRICK OF HER TRADE; WITHOUT BEING OBVIOUS COATS WERE PUT ON, TAKEN OFF, PROPS APPEARED FROM NOWHERE AS IF BY MAGIC. THE CAROL PLAYERS CAME HOME WITH MARVELLOUS WORDS OF PRAISE FOR THE HOSPITALITY GIVEN THEM BY THE PLAYMAKERS. HAVING LOST WAS INDEED A DISSAPPOINTMENT FOR THE PLAYERS OF CORNER BROOK, BUT LIKE THE TROOPERS THEY ARE THEY REJOICED WITH LABRADOR CITY/WABUSH IN THERE FIRST WIN, AND EXPRESSED THEIR GOOD WISHES, AND MORE, IN THAT THEY PROMISED THAT SOME OF THEIR PLAYERS WOULD GO TO GANDER TO GIVE THEIR SUPPORT TO THE CAROL PLAYERS AT THE REGIONAL FESTIVAL, WHERE THEY WILL COMPETE AGAINST ST. JOHNS, GRAND FALLS AND THE HOST TOWN GANDER, FOR THE TOP DRAMA HONOURS OF THE PROVINCE.

NEWFOUNDLAND IS A MEMBER OF THE ATLANTIC REGIONAL DIVISION OF THE DOMINION DRAMA FESTIVAL, AND FROM THE FOUR WINNING PLAYS IN THIS AREA ONE WILL BE CHOSEN TO REPRESENT THE ATLANTIC REGION AT THE DOMINION FESTIVAL, WHICH WILL BE HELD IN WINNIPEG.

THE MEMBERS OF THE CAROL PLAYERS WHO WERE LEFT BEHIND IN LABRADOR CITY/WABUSH STAGED A WELCOME FOR THE HOMECOMING VICTORS. AT THE AIRPORT MISS BROWN WAS PRESENTED WITH FLOWERS BY MR. ALBERT CHATWOOD. LATER IN THE EVENING AT THE RECEPTION A FORMAL TOAST WAS MADE TO MISS BROWN AND THE MEMBERS OF THE CAST OF "SPOON RIVER" AND AS BEHOVES ARTISTS THIS TOAST WAS GIVEN IN VERSE, WRITTEN AND READ BY ALBERT CHATWOOD.
