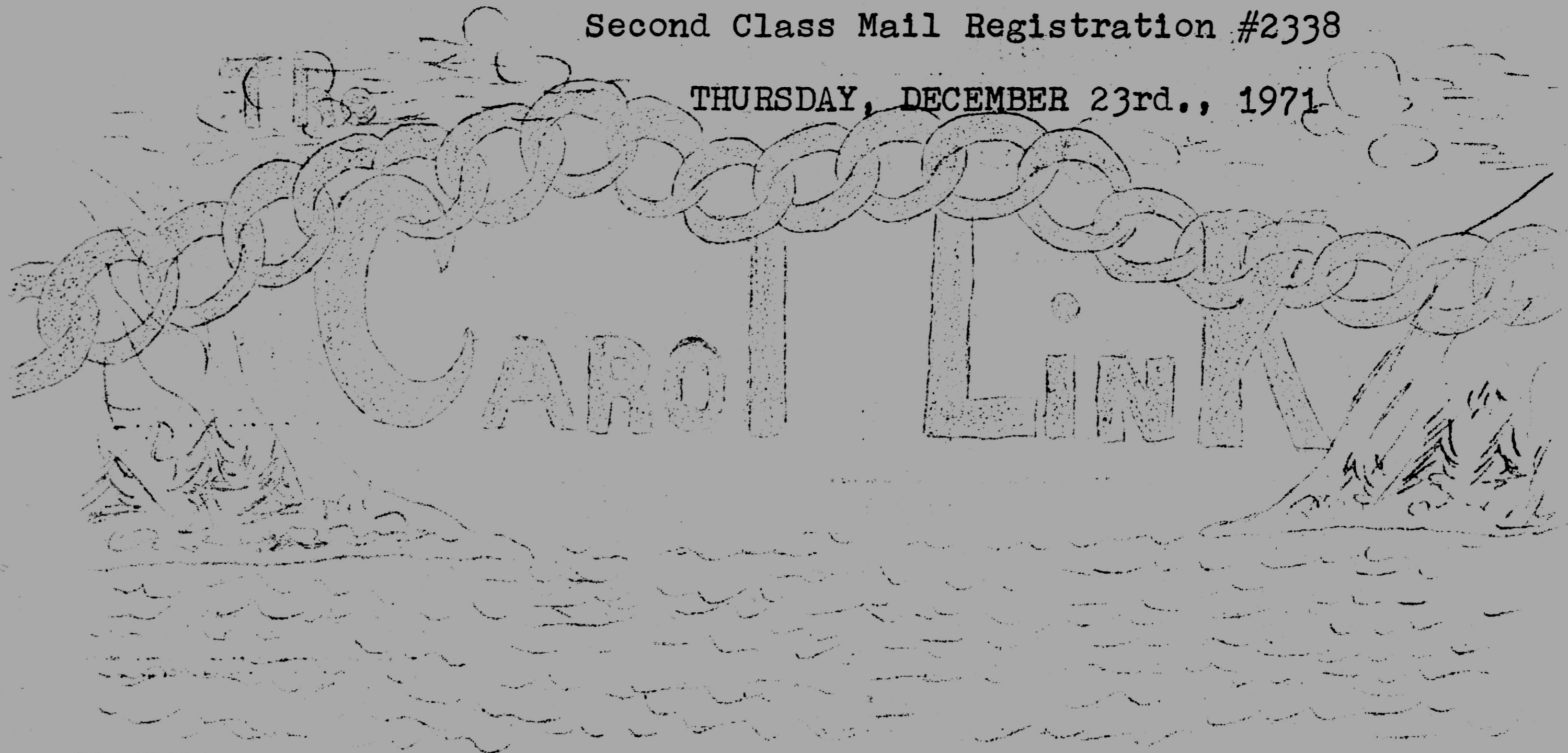

Suggested Scripture Reading: Luke 2:1-20

And it came to pass in those days, that there went out a decree from Caesar Augustus, that all the world should be taxed. Luke 2:1.

Christmas time is here again! It is time to be touched afresh by the Holy Spirit to make the festive season more precious for the One whose birth we commemorate. Christ, God's gift, is intended to be the guide, Guardian, and Constant Companion of our every waking hour. Because of this we must ask ourselves, "What does His birth mean to us?"

We answer by reading the account in the Bible and comparing our own relationship to the event. Then we look at the world and analyze the effect of the event on present activities. How much true Christianity do we see practiced?

Let us consider the matter in the light of the Sacred Record by observing the circumstances surrounding the Birth of Jesus. The circumstances were certainly unusual. A virgin was found with child by the Holy Ghost. His name, character, life, work, death, and reign had been stated in prophecy.

The unconscious obedience to the will of God by several persons is noteworthy. Worldly-minded Caesar Augustus ordered a poll tax. This brought circumstances into line with God's will. It meant that Joseph and Mary, to obey the king's injunction, took a long journey to pay their tax in their home town. A greater purpose was thus accomplished for Jesus was then born in Bethlehem and not Nazareth. The decree was given, the journey was taken, and the will of God was fulfilled.

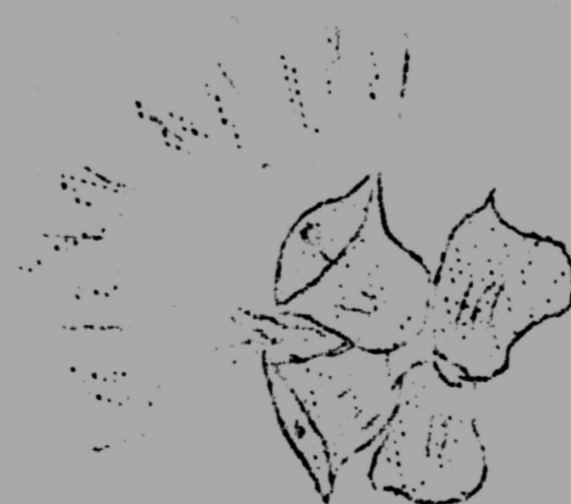
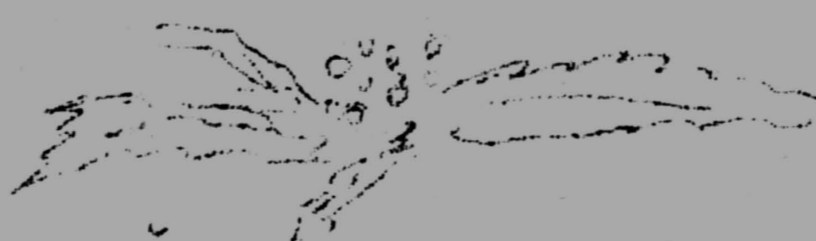

The fact of His birth needs to be stated in our day. He was born God's son, humanity's man. He was heaven's representative, and earth's Redeemer. He lived as God, and died for men.

The angel's proclamation, yet recorded by men, was a unique aspect of this birth. The angel told the joyful tidings to the sheperds in the fields; the host on high followed with a burst of heavenly song. A star became the first guided missile by leading the wisemen from afar to pay homage to the Son of God. The Gospel account gives plentiful witness to the event. The humiliation of the Son of God is the sign of His majesty and the depth of His lowliness and the height of His Glory.

The unique event was concealed from the eyes of the curious and unsympathetic world by manner of His coming. The birth was known only to whom the Lord revealed it. Born of a virgin in a lowly cattle stall He was wrapped in swaddling clothes and laid in a manger. It was the sign of the shepherds. To them he was the Lamb of God and they were the first to know, to see, and to worship at His feet.

Here was the symbol, lying in a manger, a place where the cattle fed. He was to be the bread that God sent down from heaven to feed the souls of men. Here was the signet, or seal, of all prophecy up to that moment. Prophecy is never so right as when it is fulfilled in the sight of God and men. Every last detail came about exactly as the prophets had spoken. His birth became the signal for all to begin the work of telling this joyful news: "Unto you is born this day, in the City of David, a Savior, which is Christ the Lord." 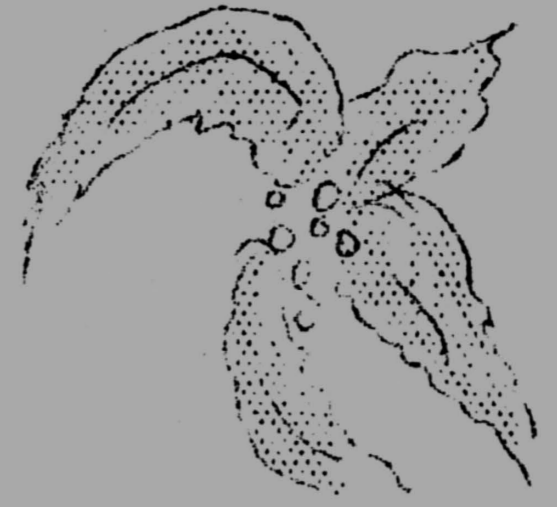
