Back in the spring of 1959, Dr. David Craig arrived to attend to the medical needs of the inhabitants of the Carol Project. At that time, there were approximately 200 men living at the old Camp Site. He had the use of a First-Aid Shack. In the fall of 1960, the Hospital opened in town, next to the Cafeteria. This too was a temporary building, but served it's purpose well.

In November 1960, Dr. Craig journeyed to England to marry Susan, and bring her back to live on Cabot Cres., which was only half built, and the only other street completed at that time was Marconi Ave. Sue was the first bride to come to Labrador City. No doubt there has been many since. In those days, Sue recalls that there were no stores, schools or churches. Bowrings store was in the Freight Office. Dr. Craig's car was the first one to be shipped into town - a Land Rover, it arrived by barge across the lakes. Some time later, the Doctor was one of a group who have the distinction of meeting the first train to pull into the station.

In 1962, Andrew was born to the Craigs, and in 1964, little Janet arrived to add joy to the family circle.

Mrs. Craig has been Chairman for 4 years of the Regional Library Board of Labrador City, and Campaign Chairman for the Community Concert Association, now going into it's 3rd year. She has also been a member of the Carol Ladies Community Club since it's conception. Both the Doctor and Sue have enjoyed skiing at our Smokey Mountain Ski Club.

And now Labrador City must say "Farewell" to these fine people. For Dr. Craig is going to Edmonton, Alberta, where he will attend University to specialize in Psychiatry. Before joining her husband in their new home, Mrs. Craig and the children will spend some time in England visiting relatives.

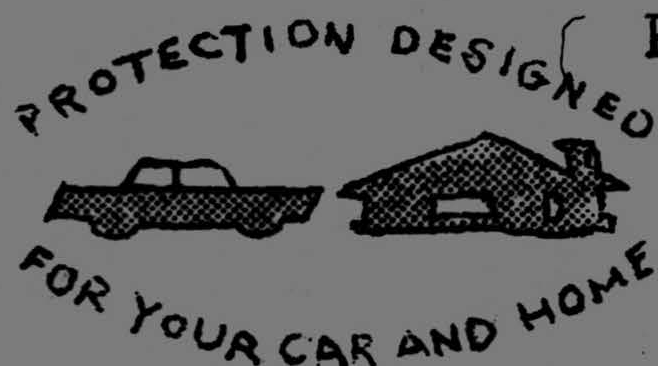

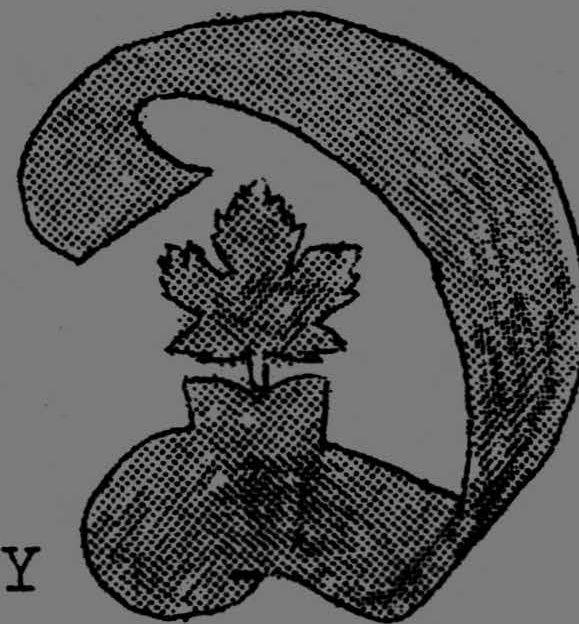

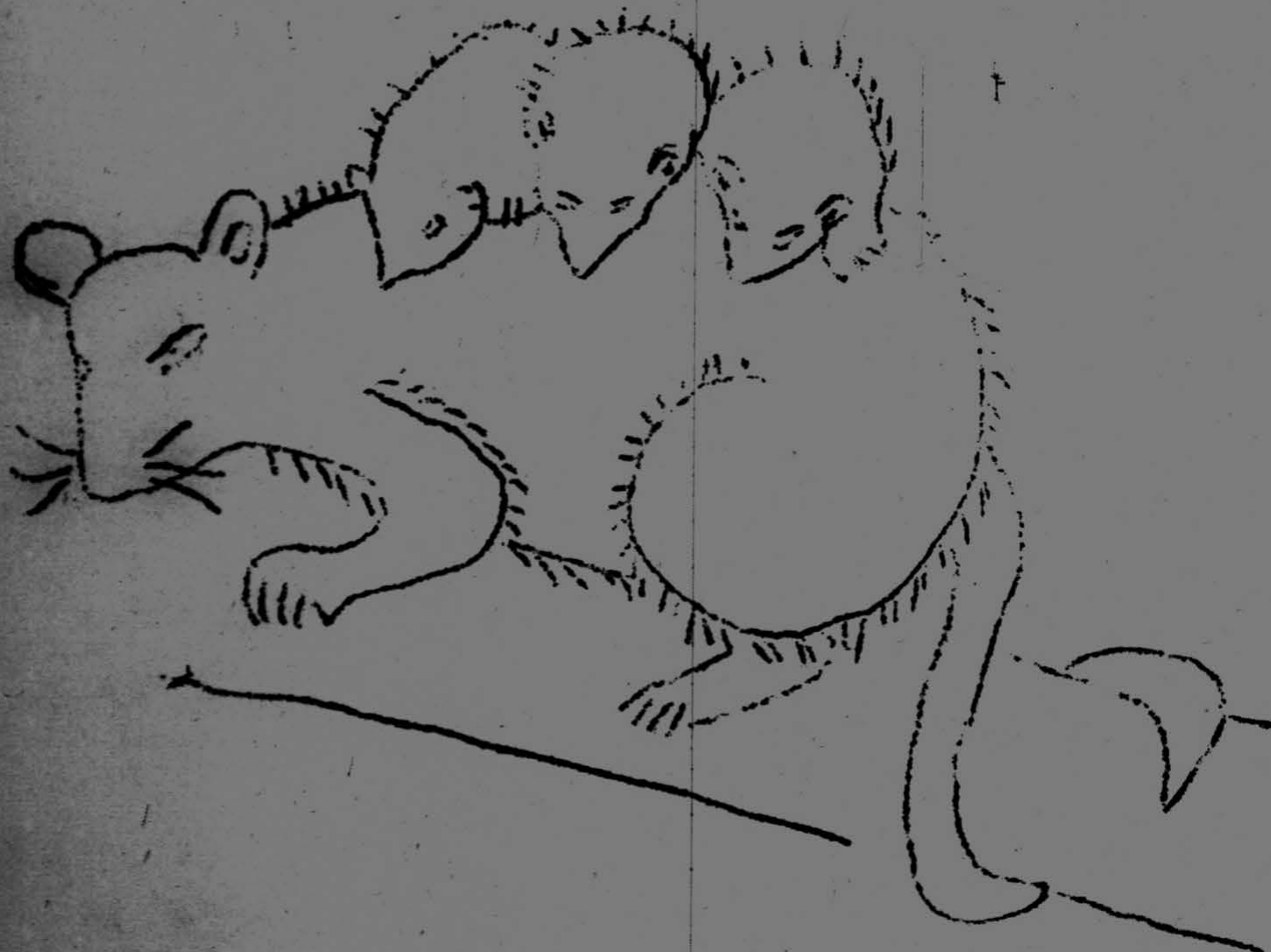
