DEAR MADAM:

IT WAS WITH GREAT INTEREST THAT I, AS A PARENT OF A TEENAGER, ATTENDED A FORUM HELD RECENTLY IN THE CAROL UNITED CHURCH, AT WHICH WERE DISCUSSED MANY QUESTIONS INVOLVING THE YOUNG PEOPLE OF TO-DAY.

IT IS FELT BY THE WRITER, AND I AM CERTAIN, BY MANY OTHERS, THAT TEENAGERS, IN ORDER TO BECOME THE CITIZENS AND LEADERS OF TO-MORROW, WHICH THE PRESENT GENERATION WOULD EXPECT AND WISH THEM TO BE, NEED A CERTAIN AMOUNT OF FREEDOM OF ACTIVITY AND SPEECH, BUT THAT THIS FREEDOM NEEDS TO BE GUIDED IN THE RIGHT DIRECTION UNTIL THE TIME COMES WHEN THEY ARE NO LONGER TEENAGERS, BUT RESPONSIBLE INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE DEVELOPED THE MORALS NEEDED TO BECOME THE BACKBONE OF A TOWN, PROVINCE OR NATION.

A RECREATION CENTRE IS URGENTLY NEEDED HERE IN LABRADOR CITY, WHERE SCHOOL AGED TEENAGERS, UNDER RESPONSIBLE SUPERVISION, COULD CONGREGATE AND HAVE DANCING AND OTHER ACTIVITIES OVER THE WEEK-ENDS.
