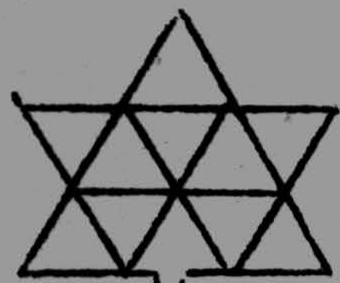

EDITORIAL

WITH THE COMING OF SPRING, WE CAN OBSERVE CHILDREN BY THE SCORE, PLAYING OUTDOORS. IT IS A WONDERFUL FEELING TO CHUCK ASIDE HEAVY COATS AND BOOTS AND FROLIC IN THE WARMER AIR AND SUN. HOWEVER, CHILDREN, BEING CHILDREN, DO MANY THINGS WHICH ENDANGER THEMSELVES.

ONE OF THESE, IS RIDING VERY CARELESSLY ON THE ROADS. EVEN THE LITTLE TOTS ON TRICYCLES HAVE BEEN KNOWN TO HALT TRAFFIC, WHILE A MOTORIST STOPS, AND ALIGHTING FROM HIS CAR, ESCORTS THE CHILD BACK TO THE SAFETY OF THE SIDE-WALK.

NOW WE DO NOT EXPECT SMALL CHILDREN TO READ THIS ARTICLE, EVEN IF THEY COULD, THE MEMORY OF IT WOULD NOT REMAIN VERY LONG WITH THEM. ON THE OTHER HAND, IT IS TO BE HOPED THAT MANY ADULTS WILL READ ON, AND DETERMINE RIGHT NOW, TO TEACH, NOT JUST ONCE, BUT DAY BY DAY, THE SAFE RULES FOR RIDING AND WALKING. MOTHERS WOULD DO WELL TO LOOK OUT OFTEN, WATCHING FOR THE SIGNS OF CARELESSNESS, ONE OF WHICH IS VERY PREVALENT IS RIDING ON THE WRONG SIDE OF THE ROAD.

ALL TOO OFTEN, PARENTS ARE APT TO TRUST THE DRIVERS, AND NOT WORRY TOO MUCH ABOUT CORRECTING THE FAULTS OF THEIR YOUNG ONES.

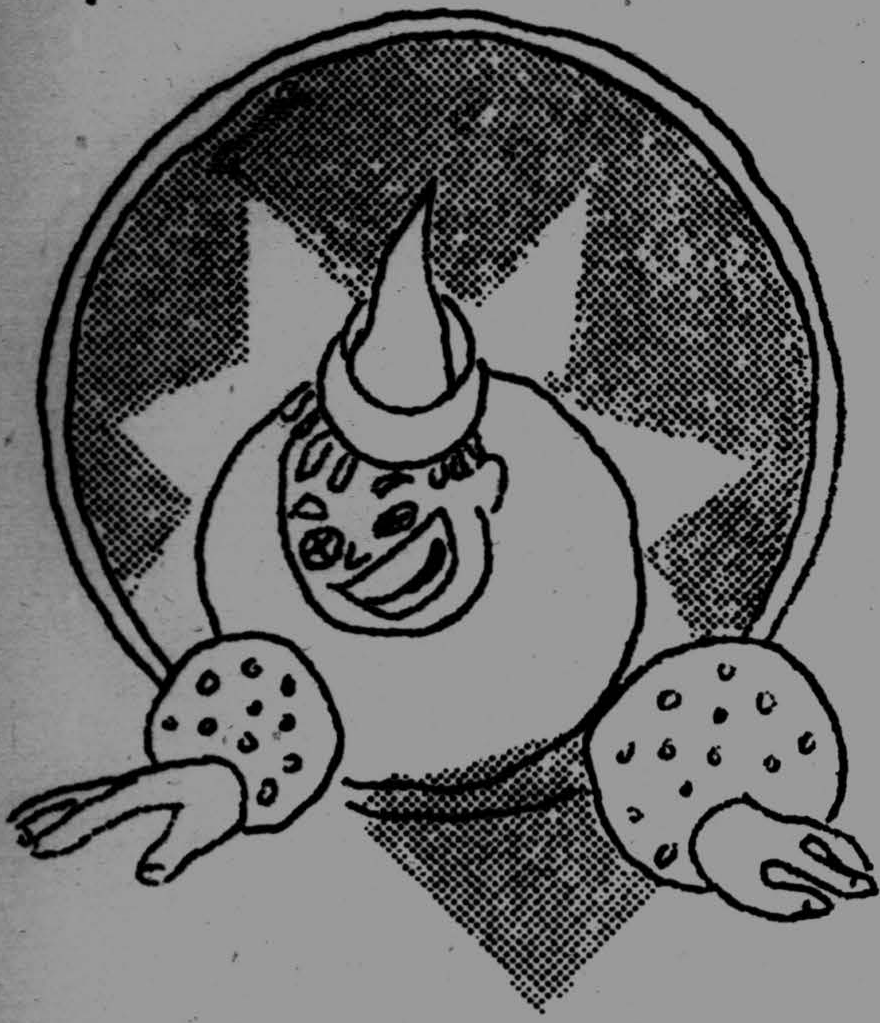

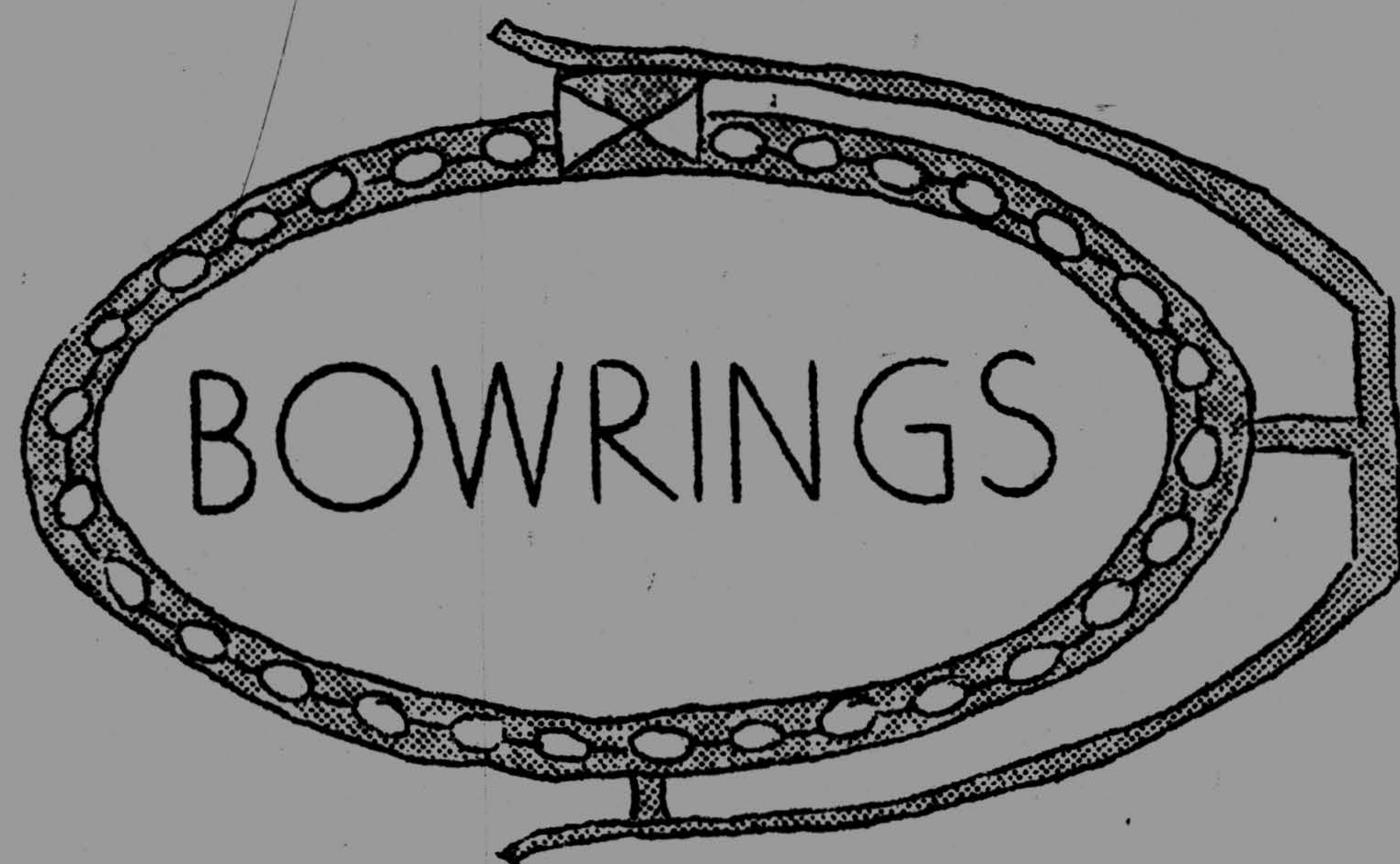
