May what you have accomplished to date help sustain you all in the coming years. All the best as we look forward to 1992-93.

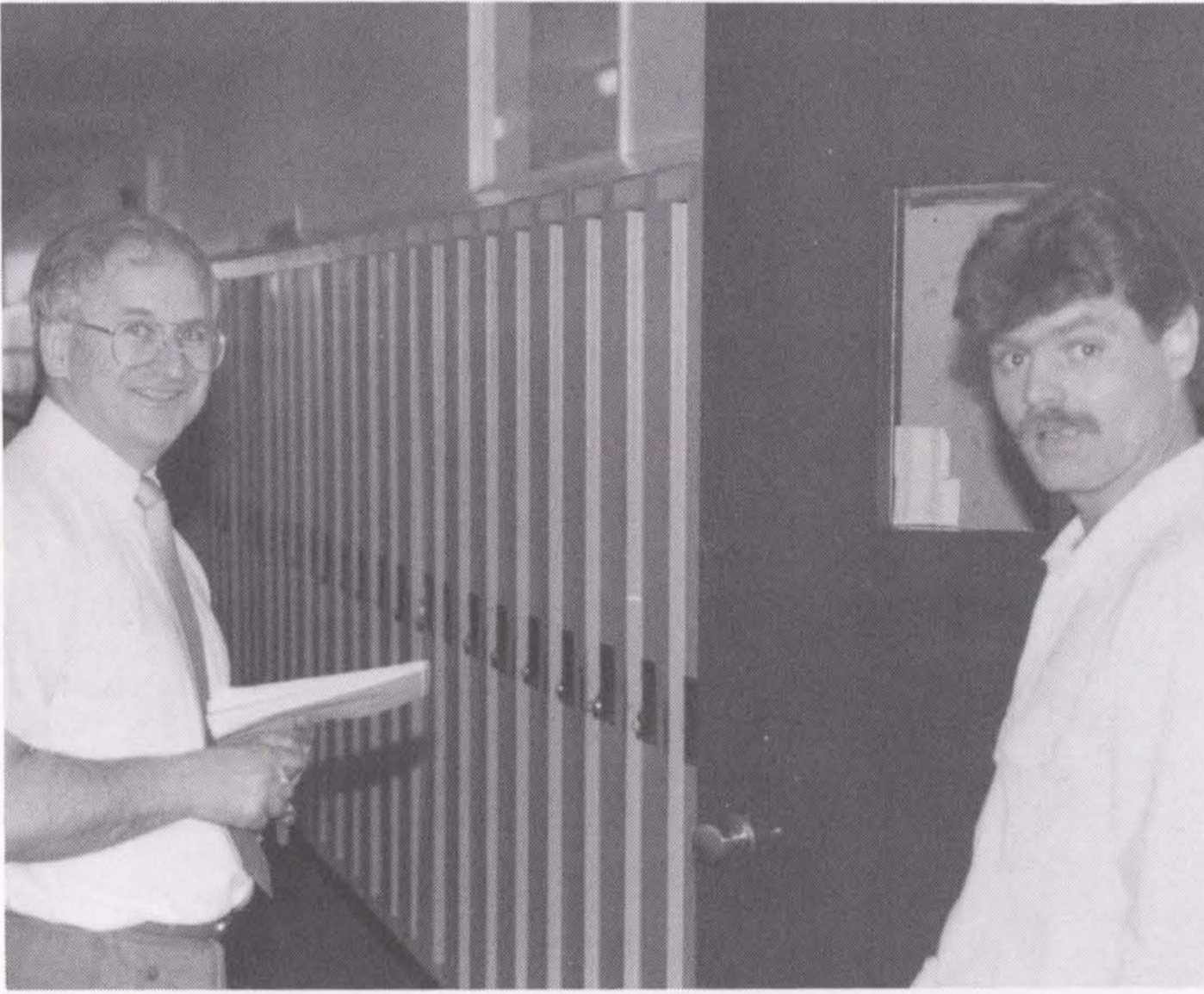
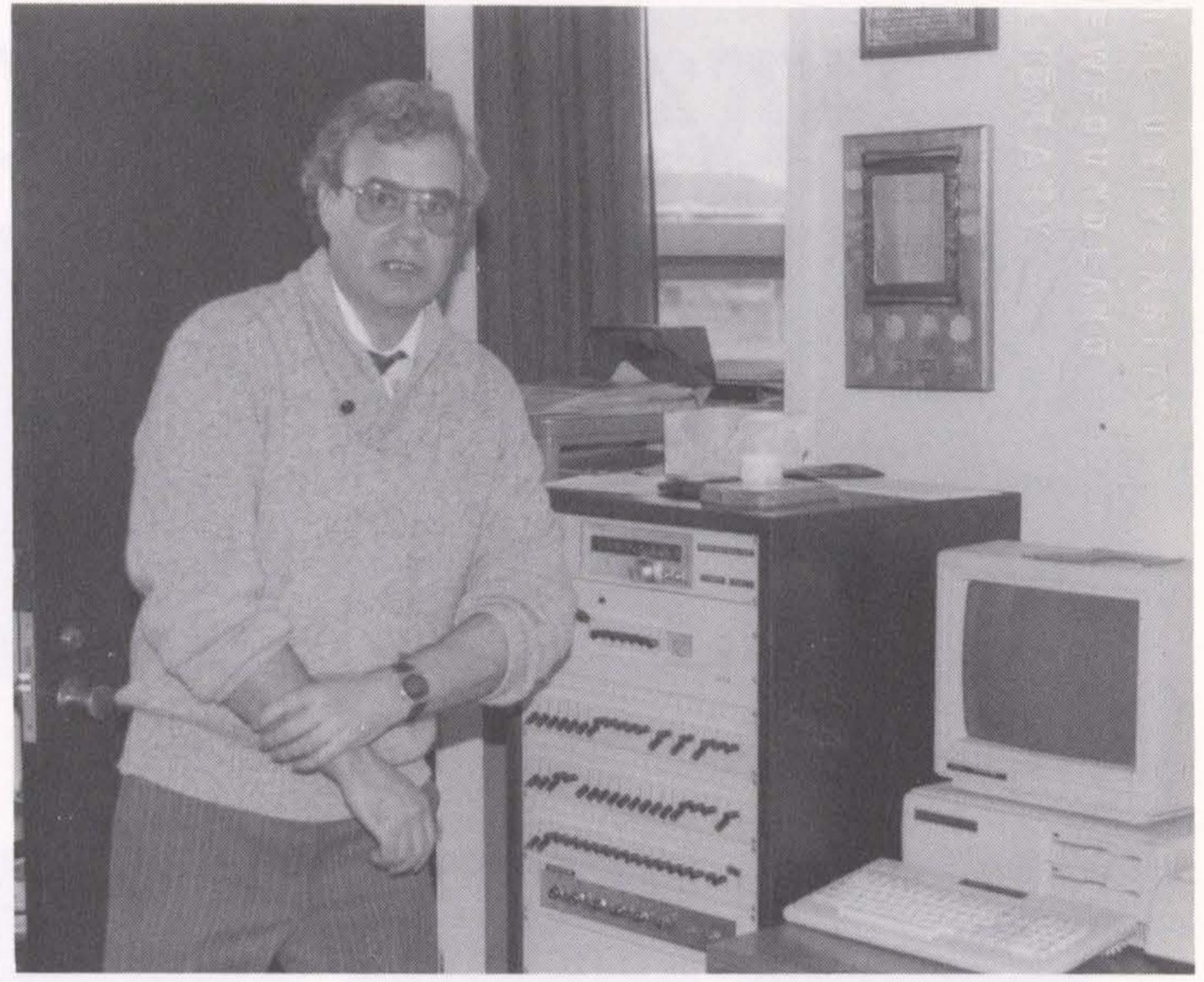
