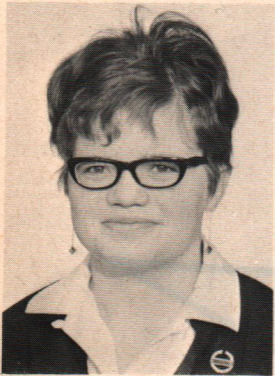
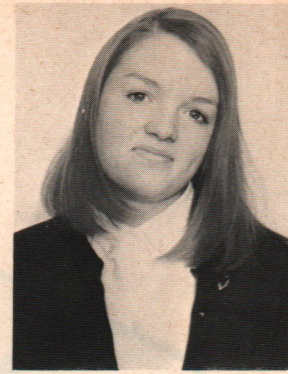


JOANNE AMBLER

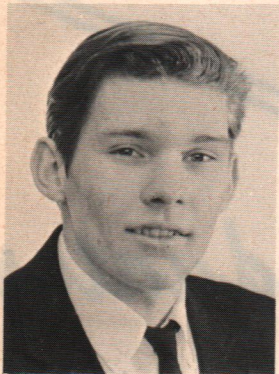


DONNA ANTLE

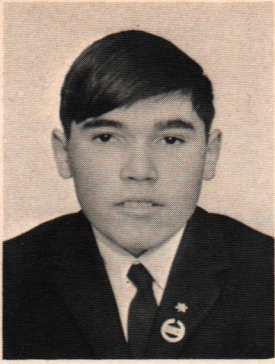
ROBERT BESNER

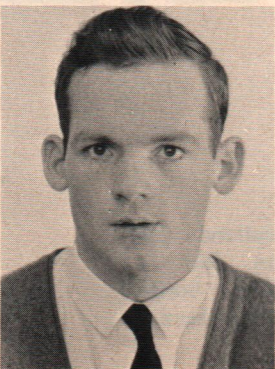


ANNETTE DAIGLE

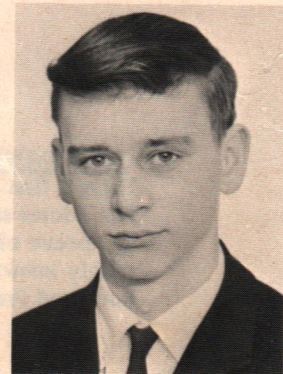


SHERYL HAWE

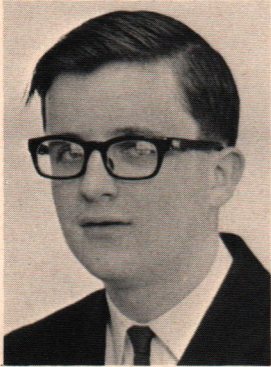


STELLA KELLY

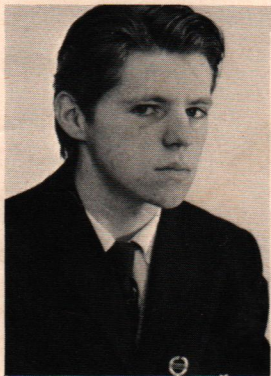
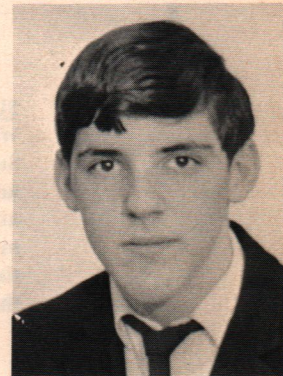


DONALD MacDONALD

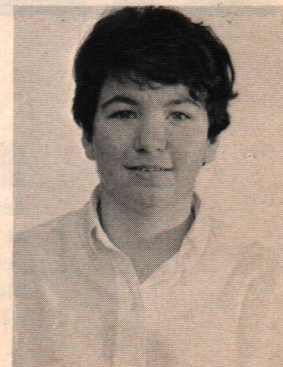


ZENON MISSON

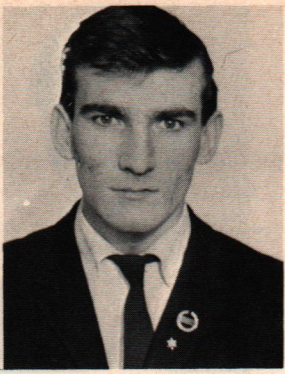
JAMES ROUGH

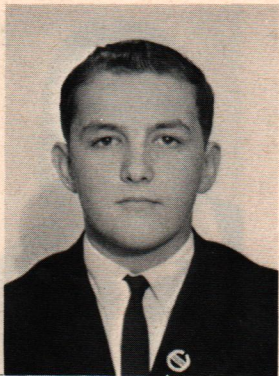
CALVIN SMITH

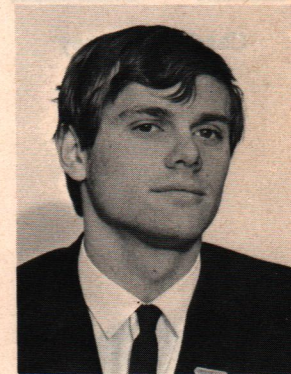
PATRICIA SMITH

BUD STEEVES

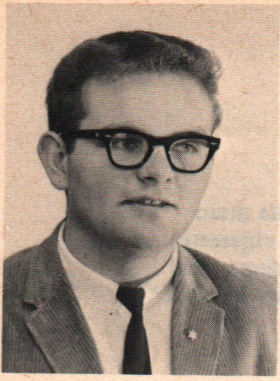

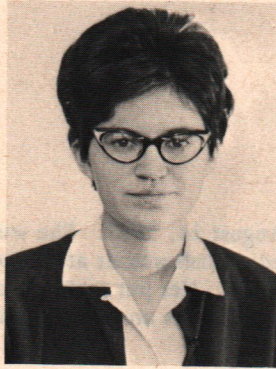

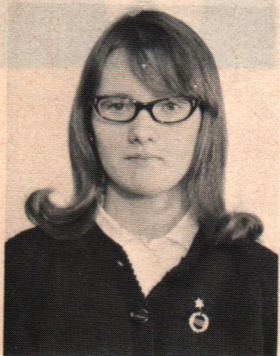
